VetNEST Summer School 2023 Animal Welfare, Veterinary Ethics, Law and Communication Skills 10 – 14 July 2023, Zagreb, Croatia

Who: Eligible students will be in their **4**th-**6**th **year of veterinary training** during the time of the Summer School. **22 students** will be selected to participate. (Two per VetNEST-Extended partner institution – see top left box)

What: This Summer School will include class and practical work, group activities and farm visits with a focus on animal welfare, ethics, law, communication and conflict management. The program was created based on their horizontal integration. Participants will improve their communication strategies and become familiar with important and diverging concepts of animal health and diseases, learn about responsibilities to being professional as a vet in different roles. Learn how you can speak up for animal welfare and apply professional veterinary ethics in farm systems, while being a service provider. Students will work practically on diverse cases with the intention of working on different customer demands.

Topics include: • Management input on small-scale farms and extensive production systems • <u>Resource based inputs</u> • <u>Animal-based measures in different systems</u>
<u>Expectations of consumers that food be produced locally or regionally with</u>

acceptable animal welfare conditions • Communication skills • Legal basis and policy measures • Dealing with moral challenges

Why: To learn about responsibilities of veterinary professionals in small-scale farms, extensive production systems and industrialized agriculture.

Where: Course work will be based at the Campus of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine of University of Zagreb in Zagreb and accommodation is arranged in a nearby student dormitory. Students are responsible for their own travel arrangements.

When: July 10th – 14th 2023 Application deadline April 30, 2023

Applications must include:

- Motivation letter (min. 300, max. 500 words)
- Curriculum vitae in Europass format
- Short Letter of Recommendation (e.g. from a faculty member)
- Transcript of Records (if possible in English)

Successful applicants will be notified within two weeks after the application deadline. They will then be asked to submit their CEEPUS applications (scholarship) by April 30, 2023.
