The administration of the entrance exam in the THIRD enrollment period at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, University of Belgrade, began and concluded according to the established plan on October 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025 for Latin as well as for Biology and Chemisty.

Only one candidate applied for studies in veterinary medicine in English and participated in the entrance exam. The exam took place in the Dean's conference room. The examination proceeded smoothly without any objections from the candidate.

Based on the information provided and in accordance with the Admission Competition for the first year of undergraduate and integrated studies, a PRELIMINARY RANKING LIST has been determined for the third enrollment period in 2025, after adding up the points obtained based on high school performance and the entrance exam.

The candidate has the option to file a complaint (both first and second instance) regarding the regularity of the admission procedure, the regularity of the entrance exam, or their position on the preliminary ranking list no later than October 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 12:00.

After resolving the received appeals and complaints, the Faculty will establish and publish the FINAL RANKING LIST.

The FINAL RANKING LIST will be published no later than October 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025, by 12:00.

- A candidate can be admitted as a self-financed student if they are ranked within the number of self-financed students approved for admission according to this faculty's competition and have at least 30 points.
